Accessibility means that people with and without disabilities can interact with websites, mobile applications, and other technologies. Accessibility advocacy is global, and the EU and Spain have the legal foundation to support an inclusive digital world. In the United States a collaborative legal strategy known as Structured Negotiation has been used by blind advocates, other people with disabilities, and lawyers to improve accessibility with private corporations, the government sector, education, and more. All without lawsuits, all with significant involvement of the disability community. In the 21st century, digital inclusion is fundamental to participation in society and cooperative legal strategies can help.
